Public Lands Committee Report

Greetings:

Even though it's early in the year, things are already in the works! We're discussing a partnership with the Forest Service to help maintain the Transfer Stock Corrals. More to come there. We are in the process of applying for a BCHA grant to help install a three sided manure bin, to make it easier for folks to keep the stalls clean and for the FS to tractor the manure out. Keep an eye out for our breakout party to get the stock camp area up and running for the season and join us for a fun weekend of camping, riding, site work and cooking.

Of course this doesn't take the place of our favorite COTREX, <u>trailscolorado.gov</u>. We'll be having another demo on this for our new folks and the general public in March so join us for our monthly meeting. Sure to be loads of fun.

The Rico Trails Project draft EA is out for public comment. It is an analysis of proposed trails, reroutes and improvements to the Spring Creek, Ryman, Rio Grande Southern and Circle trails. The proposed project consists of new motorized and non-motorized trails and existing trail reroutes on U.S. Forest Service lands in the vicinity of Rico, CO. A 3.4-mile new single track motorized trail would provide a connection between Stoner and Taylor Mesas. In conjunction with the new Spring Creek Trail construction, 1.9 miles of motorized single track and 9.7 miles of non-motorized trail would be decommissioned. Two new non-motorized trails (Rio Grande Southern-4.4 miles and Circle Trail-2.6 miles) would provide connection to existing trails and loop opportunities. The existing Ryman Creek Trail would be re-aligned to provide a more sustainable and accessible trail. Please click here to see the documents, maps and to comment.







